What is the Dr. John H. Hoagland, C.P.M. Scholarship Fund?

The purpose of the scholarship fund is to promote the supply management discipline and provide assistance to qualified applicants who have exhibited a keen interest and commitment in furthering supply management professionalism.

Eligibility

Applicants must be currently enrolled in an accredited college or university.

Determination of Scholarship Recipients

Scholarship recipients will be chosen by the Dr. John H. Hoagland, C.P.M. Scholarship Fund Evaluating Committee. The evaluating committee will consist of:

- 1 Current ISM-Central Michigan Board Member
- 1 Regular Member
- 1 Academician

Recipients will be selected according to an established point structure assigned to the following categories:

- Academic Credentials
- Academic Plans and Career Goals
- Community Service
- Service to ISM
- Leadership
- Employment

Availability of Scholarships

ISM-CM utilizes proceeds from its annual Michigan Purchasing Conference to fund the scholarship. As such availability of scholarship funds is tied to profits from the conference. Scholarship award may be in value up to \$1,500.

Award(s) will be presented at the ISM – Central Michigan Purchasing Conference on November 9th, recipients may be guest(s) of the association. The number of scholarships to be awarded each year will be determined by the Board of Directors of ISM – Central Michigan, Inc.

Who is Dr. John H. Hoagland, C.P.M?

Dr. John H. Hoagland, C.P.M. has distinguished himself through services and educational contributions to ISM - Central Michigan, Inc., the Institute for Supply Management, industry, educational institutions, as well as government by advancing the purchasing profession and stressing the importance of purchasing in the business cycle. It is in Dr. Hoagland's honor that the scholarship fund has been founded.

Dr. Hoagland's solid belief in the importance of the purchasing profession has been espoused in his writings and lectures to students, academicians, government and industry managers, and in the establishment of purchasing curricula at Michigan State University, which now graduates more purchasing majors than any other university in the world.

Dr. John H. Hoagland, C.P.M. had been a member of ISM – Central Michigan, Inc. Board of Directors for many years and had served in numerous local committee chair positions. He has also served on the NAPM Professional Journal Committee and helped institute the *Journal of Purchasing and Materials Management*. His Business Survey of leading indicators of business and economic trends was published in the *N.A.P.A. Bulletin* for over a decade.

Dr. Hoagland has received numerous awards and honors, including the ISM J. Shipman Gold Medal Award, 1989; the NAPM Professorship, 1985; Garneir-Themoir Gold Medal - International Federation of Purchasing and Materials Management, 1985; Paul Harris Fellow - Rotary International, 1985; the Homer Hauger Award – ISM - Central Michigan, Inc., 1982; Robert Angell Award – ISM - Central Michigan, Inc., 1981; and Certified Purchasing Manager (C.P.M.), 1975.

Well over twenty years ago, in conjunction with ISM - Central Michigan, Inc., he originated the Michigan Purchasing Conference held annually and that now continues as the Central Michigan Purchasing Conference. It is the success of this conference that allows this scholarship fund to be a reality.
